



Questions for SESSION 3: Your One-ness

1. What struck you about the video? What didn't make sense?
2. If you were asked before this course, "What is the Christian life?" what would you have said? (i.e. What's been your impression of what Christianity's all about?)
3. How do you respond to this description: "The Christian life is like a marriage – it's an all-of-life one-ness with Jesus"? Does that challenge your impression of Christianity? (Is it attractive? Baffling? Something else?)
4. Many people say they struggle to have faith. If faith is "receiving Jesus" (like in a marriage), how does that help our understanding?
5. In the video, Glen said that unconditional love makes us *less* likely to be unfaithful. Do you agree or disagree? If it's true, what does it mean for our "marriage-like" relationship with Jesus?
6. If we are one with Jesus, what are the implications for our relationship with God? With others? With day to day life?
7. What have been your experiences with church? The bible? Prayer?
8. How do these things relate to "oneness with Jesus"?
9. What would it look like for *you* to be one with Jesus? (Think big. Think specifics.)
 - a. Would you like to receive Jesus for yourself?
 - b. Would you like to keep investigating Jesus?
